The above items are based on a point system. An entry may receive all or a portion of the points. Judging will be based on membership as of October 1, of each year & divided into five groups:

Group 1 - 1 to 20 members; Group 2 21 to 40 members; and Group 3 - 41 to 75 members; Group 4 - 76 plus members; Group 5 New Clubs formed after October 1 each year.

Bulletins, ten (10), should be in a book form and submitted no later than at the Ohio District Convention in August. Each club should be encouraged to publish a bulletin whether or not it qualifies for competition. The main purpose of the bulletin is communication.

OHIO DISTRICT INCENTIVE

- \$25 dues refund from the Ohio District for each new member added between June 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021.
- The Ohio District will pay a refund to the clubs for the first 150 new members added throughout the Ohio District.
- To receive the incentive your club's total number of members on October 1, 2021 must be greater than your club's June 1, 2021 total number of members. This incentive is to reflect positive growth within your club.
- The Ohio District will pay the dues refunds to your club in October 2021.
- This incentive is for adding new members to your existing club and does not include new club building.
