Message from our 2020-2021 Ohio District Governor

Fellow Ohio District Optimists

We have begun the last month of the 2020-2021 "BE THE CHANGE – CHOOSE OPTIMISM" year. There is still time to accomplish our goals and finish out the year Strong! Last month I challenged ever club to add 1 new member in August & in September. It is not too late to ask a friend, neighbor, co-worker or family member to join your club. Let Optimism do its work to gain new members. Our communities and our youth need you more than ever!

Remember Optimist International and The Great Ohio District has offered financial incentives to your club for adding new members to your club. Optimist International has waived the new member \$15 fee. Any new members added between June 1 until September 30th, 2021 will save the \$15 fee. The Great Ohio District has offered a \$25 dues refund from the Ohio District for each new member added between June 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021. To receive the incentive your club's total number of members on October 1, 2021 must be greater than your club's June 1, 2021 total number of members. This incentive is to reflect positive growth within your club. The Ohio District will pay the dues refunds to your club in October 2021

Also, it is not too late to build a new club. So far this year the Ohio District has built/sponsored 4 new clubs. There are at least 2 more new clubs in process. Optimist International President Patsy Garner has announced an incentive that a new club built in September will also be credited to the Ohio District new club building goal next Optimist year. Let's work to build new clubs in September that will also count next year for Governor Designate Greg Griffin and the 2021 – 2022 team. Let's finish the job!

I want to thank each and every one of you who has assisted in making the 2020-2021 "BE THE CHANGE – CHOOSE OPTIMISM" year a success! It has been a challenging year for everyone, but we were able overcome the obstacles. Our first conference was held in person, complete with masks and social distancing but with was a great success in attendance and content. Second quarter conference, we had a completely virtual conference with several Optimist International dignitaries training and speaking. Our third quarter conference we recapped the virtual District Oratorical contest, focused on membership, and completed a district wide service project. • \$15 OI Processing Fee has been waived for adding new members to your club membership roster thru September 30, 2021.

OHIO DISTRICT INCENTIVE

- \$25 dues refund from the Ohio District for each new member added between June 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021.
- The Ohio District will pay a refund to the clubs for the first 150 new members added throughout the Ohio District.
- To receive the incentive your club's total number of members on October 1, 2021 must be greater than your club's June 1, 2021 total number of members. This incentive is to reflect positive growth within your club.
- The Ohio District will pay the dues refunds to your club in October 2021.
- This incentive is for adding new members to your existing club and does not include new club building.
