Hello Fellow Optimists,

I have two (more) exciting things to share with you this month: First, our 74th Annual Ohio District Optimist Convention was held on August 11-13 at Embassy Suites in Dublin Ohio.

THANKS TO EVERYONE WHO ATTENDED AND HELPED MAKE THIS YEAR'S CONVENTION ONE OF OUR BEST EVER! (And this is not just the leadership team saying this was an excellent convention, it was feedback from the convention surveys completed by the attendees – fantastic!

Some of the highlights:

- The members elected our Ohio District Governor for the 2023-2024 Optimist Year – Tom Kennedy – Lt. Governor for Zone 5, and member of the Troy Noon Optimist Club
- Bill Stone our Governor for the 2022-2023 Optimist Year which starts in just under 30 days, and his leadership team were officially installed
- The Convention delegates approved the 2023 Ohio District Convention Location – Dayton, Ohio – our 75th Convention
- Spouses and Guests of Lt. Governors (and others) in the Friday Training Session had a fun time in Dublin creating a painting to take home, enjoying lunch, and topping it all off with Graeter's Ice Cream
- We reimagined Convention Friday Night as a pizza and subs party and everyone had a wonderful experience. (BTW Tommy's Pizza in the Columbus Area is to die for)
- Saturday Evening, we had a delicious Governor's Banquet with our Optimist International Dignitaries – our dear friends Bob and Penny McFadyen, and our very special guest, Optimist International Foundation President Marc Katz.
- To cap off a wonderful banquet and installation ceremony, we were treated to a Blues Brother's tribute show that was simply astounding. Everyone who attended the show eve received a pair of sunglasses to get in the spirit of the evening and boy did they ever!

Governor Designate Bill Stone and his team are planning an even bigger and better convention for 2023 – so do not miss out – come join us – you will be glad you did.

Second, we STILL have a terrific Fourth Quarter Membership Incentive to reward clubs for bringing in new members in the 4th quarter. For each new member added in Q4 (July 1 – September30) the club will earn \$25 from the district to spend any way they wish. The only stipulation for the \$25 award to be paid is that the club must be+1 in members for the period of Q4. Put a different way – if a club starts the fourth quarter with, say, 15 members, adds 2, which means they end at 17 (+2 for the quarter they earn \$25 x 2 or \$50). Pretty easy. On the other hand, if a club starts with 15 members on July 1, loses 3 members, adds 2 members the net for Q4 is -1. In this event no incentive for the 2 added members will be paid.

I sound like a broken record I know – but.... WHO DO YOU – YES, YOU – KNOW THAT WOULD BENEFIT FROM SERVING THE COMMUNITY AND SPECIFICALLY KIDS WHILE AT THE SAME TIME HAVING FUN DOING IT? Invite them TO A MEETING OR A CLUB EVENT TO SEE US IN ACTION!!!! It's been a joy for us to serve as Governor and First Lady in the BEST DISTRICT in all of Optimist International. As we wind down our year, we are SO EXCITED about the future with two wonderful Governors on the horizon – Bill Stone and Tom Kennedy. "The Best is Yet to Be".

- \$25 dues refund from the Ohio District for each new member added between July 1, 2022, and September 30, 2022.
- The Ohio District will pay a refund to the clubs for the first 150 new members added throughout the Ohio District.
- To receive the incentive your club's total number of members on October 1, 2022, must be greater than your club's July 1, 2022, total number of members. This incentive is to create positive growth within your club.
- The Ohio District will pay the dues refunds to your club in November 2022. The refunds will be in the form of a check and can be spent any way the club decides.
- This incentive is for adding new members to your existing club and does not include new club building.

It's our FINAL PUSH for membership recruitment. Your club has an opportunity to save \$25 on each new member added between July 1, 2022, and September 30, 2022. Now is the time to add NEW Members!!
