

OHIO DISTRICT CLUB RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Honor Club Tracking Form and Supplemental Form are designed to provide information to the Zone Lt. Governor and the District to assist your individual club and be a part of the Ohio District Club Recognition Program (CRP). The forms are to be submitted quarterly to your Lt. Governor and the Chair of the Club Recognition Program. The forms are to be submitted no later than the 10th of the month following the end of each quarter – January 10, April 10, July 10, and October 10.

Instructions:

Heading: List your Club Name & Number

Membership: Record adds, moves (deletes) and net (difference between adds & moves) each month of the quarter on the Honor Club Tracking Form. Conduct a Now/Wow/Recruitment Program and record on Honor Club Tracking Form.

Administrative: Record dates District & International Dues are paid and submission dates for the Club Officer Report & Club Pride Report on the Honor Club Tracking Form. Record date of IRS Form 990 filing, quarterly submission of CRP forms, and document & submit community project reports on Supplemental Tracking Form.

Charitable – Foundation: Record name of your Club Foundation Representative and amount of club unrestricted donation to the Optimist International Foundation.

Education – District Meetings: Record number of attendees at District Convention, Meetings & Conferences on the Honor Club Tracking Form.

Education – Learning Management System: Record completion dates for the Club President, Club Foundation Rep and Club Secretary/Treasurer training on the Optimist International Learning Management System.

Education- Meetings: Record attendance at Zone Meetings, District Conferences, District Convention and Optimist International Convention on the Supplemental Form.

Service: Record club service & community projects on the Honor Club Tracking Form. Additional projects can be added to bottom of the Supplemental Tracking Form.

Optimist International Youth Club (JOI) & Community Youth Groups: For the current Optimist Year record annually JOI clubs sponsored, new JOI clubs organized, community youth groups sponsored, and sport teams sponsored on the Supplemental Tracking Form. Sponsorship/support must be beyond a monetary donation.

New Club Organization: For the current Optimist Year record any new Adult, College or Special Needs clubs that were built.

Community – Club/Community Recognition: Recognize a Club Member or a Community Member (Adult or Youth) and document on the Optimist International Club Pride Report.

Winner Recognition:

Clubs will be divided into 4 classes for recognition based on size and official membership numbers at Optimist International as of October 1st. Class A – clubs with 75 + members; Class B – clubs with 41-74 members; Class C – clubs with 21-40 members; and Class D – clubs with 20 or less members.

Top point earner in each class will win a Cash Gift.

<u>Banner Patch Recognitions</u>: All can be earned thru completing Honor Club & Supplemental Tracking Forms

Community Service Award: Recognize a Youth, conduct a Respect for Law program & complete three community service activities.

Friend of Youth: Host an Oratorical or Essay or CCDHH Contest and sponsor a youth club – JOI or community youth group. Youth Group Sponsorship/support must be beyond a monetary donation.

Partners in Education: Conduct an Optimist International Communication Program (Essay, Oratorical, CCDHH, Kids Speak Out, Musical Happiness, Photography Contest, Virtual Arts Contest), present an award to an educator & conduct a school/education related service project (Examples include Poster Contest, Talent Show, etc...)

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

Conduct an OI "NOW WOW or Recruitment Program" during the year: Where, when, # attendees, # joined (minimum of 3 must join).

Grow your Club (Net +3 for the year)

Appoint a Club Foundation Rep & Club (not individual) make at least a \$100 dollar unrestricted donation to the OIF/CCOF (OIF funds OI)

Investigate establishing an ACH payment system with Optimist International for payment of dues on a timely basis

Be current on dues to OI & District (must be paid, in full, by year-end September 30th)

Recognize a Club Member or Community Member on an annual basis (Optimist of the Year)

TWO reports completed by their due dates:

- Club Officer Elect Report (COER) due May 20th or immediately following Club elections.
- Club Pride Report due by September 30th

Club President, Club President-Elect (or two Designees) attend District Convention (or two other District meetings/conferences)

Club Foundation Representative completes the CFR training on the Optimist International Learning Management System

Club President completes the Club President training on the Optimist International Learning Management System

Club Secretary/Treasurer completes the Club S/T training on the Optimist International Learning Management System
